SEN parent forums, where parents can meet the SENDco and other parents are held each half term.

We have 3 parents evenings each year to discuss progression

Parents of pupils with a SEN are given additional meeting with the SENDco each year.

Our class teachers regularly, informally update parents before and after school.

We send home an annual report for parents detailing their learning each year.

Teacher's hold regular information evenings covering calculations, phonics and EYFS.
