

My Child has been identified as having a Special Educational Need. What happens next?

Try not to worry. We will support you and your child in every step of the learning journey at St Paul's.

Firstly, your family and school will have a meeting to create a Support Plan together. The plan will include learning leaps to help your child achieve their very best, in school and at home.

We will make changes to the way we support your child in school e.g. some individual support or changing some of the equipment your child uses.

Next you might be asked to give permission for a specialist to see your child e.g. a Speech and Language Therapist. This will help parents and teachers to understand your child's particular needs.

We will always involve your family in reviewing support plans and progress by inviting you to meetings throughout the year.

Most importantly we encourage your child's voice and input at every step of their learning journey.
